The Municipal Election Commission of the City of Bishopville, SC, announces the general election for Bishopville, SC to be Tuesday, November 8, 2016.

The following offices shall be included in this election: Six (6) City Council Members.

The polling places for this election are:

Ward 1: Lee County Fire Department, 122 E. Church Street, Bishopville, SC

Ward 2: Old Fire Station, 113 E. Council Street, Bishopville, SC

Ward 3: Pilot Home, 112 Barnett Drive, Bishopville, SC

Ward 4: Lee County Vocational School, 310 Roland Street, Bishopville, SC

People desiring to vote in the upcoming election must be registered by October 8, 2016. To register, one must contact the Lee County Board of Voter Registration, 101 Gregg Street, Bishopville, SC, 29010, phone 803-484-1832.

Citizens desiring to be candidates for the above listed offices may file in the office of the Municipal Clerk at Bishopville City Hall, 135 E. Church Street, Bishopville, SC, 29010. Books will be open for filing at 12:00 noon on Monday, August 1, 2016, and remain open during regular business hours until 12:00 noon on Monday, August 15, 2016.

The filing fee for the office of council is \$200.00. At the time of filing, all interested parties must file both a Statement of Candidacy and a Statement of Economic Interests. The Statement of Candidacy will be provided by the Municipal Clerk. The Statement of Economic Interests must be filed online; the Municipal Clerk will provide instructions. A confirmation of filing must be presented to the Bishopville Municipal Clerk before all filing is complete.

Candidates for this position must be residents and registered electors of the City of Bishopville and must reside in the City for at least 30 days prior to the election. This is a nonpartisan election, and no party affiliation shall be placed on the ballot.

The polls shall open at 7:00 a.m. on Election Day, November 8, 2016, and close at 7:00 p.m. on November 8, 2016.

Absentee voting will be October 10, 2016 thru November 7, 2016, at 101 Gregg Street, Bishopville, SC 29010, phone (803)484-1832.

At 7:00 p.m. on said Election Day, the poll managers will begin examining the absentee ballots. This examination will be held at the 101 Gregg Street, Bishopville, SC 29010.

On Thursday, November 10, 2016, at 10:00 a.m. at the Colclough Building, 109 E. Council Street, Bishopville, SC, 29010, the Municipal Election Commission will hold a hearing to determine the validity of ballots challenged in this election.
